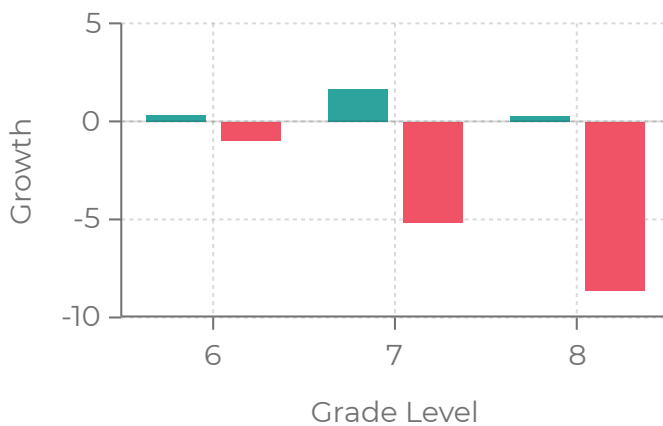

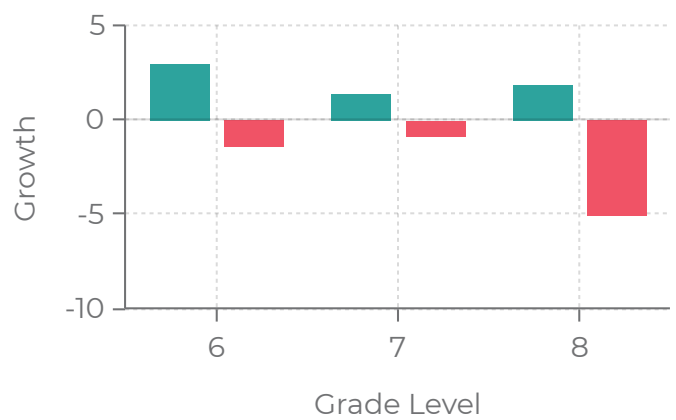

This study compares the growth achieved by Mississippi students who met Classworks recommended usage guidelines during the 2020 Fall to Winter test window to their peers who did not use Classworks or meet the recommended usage guidelines during the same period.

Students in grades six, seven, and eight who met Classworks recommended usage guidelines experienced measurable growth across all grade levels on both the Classworks Reading and Math assessments from the Fall to Winter period. These students experienced, on average, 5.7% more growth in ELA and 4.5% more growth in math. This growth is in stark contrast to students in the same grades who did not meet Classworks recommended usage and resulted in a sharp decline on both assessments across all grade levels.

For the purposes of this study, Classworks recommended usage is defined as: completing more than one unit, achieving an overall unit mastery score greater than 75%, and time-on-task of at least 20 hours throughout the entire Fall to Winter period.
