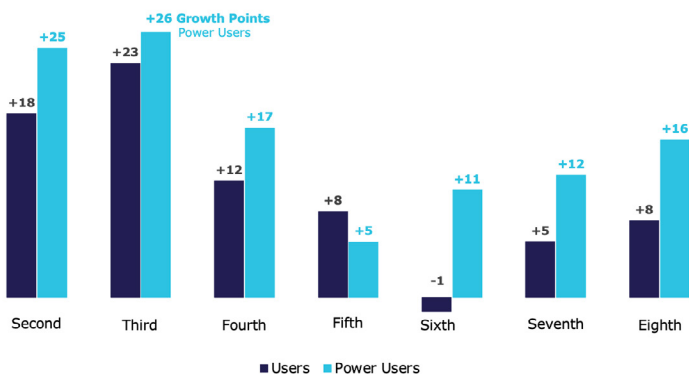




Special Education Achievement Study

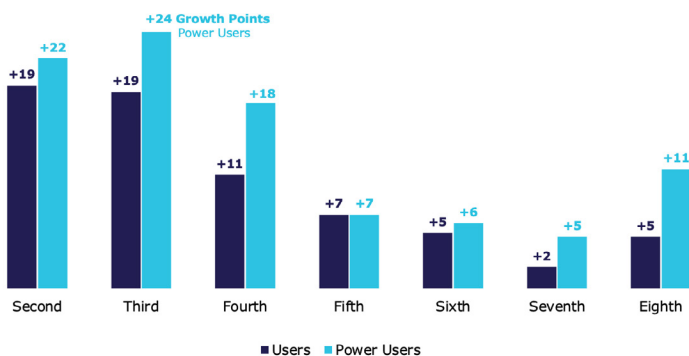
Fall 2022 to Winter 2023

Reading Growth Points



Special Education students across grades 2 through 8 who used Classworks Individualized Learning and followed usage recommendations (Power Users) experienced more growth from fall to winter on their Classworks Reading and Math Universal Screener Assessments, when compared to their peers who did not follow usage recommendations.

Math Growth Points



On average, Special Education students in grades two through eight who used Classworks grew 10 points in reading. Power Users grew an average of 16 points!

In math, Special Education students in grades two through eight who used Classworks Individualized Learning grew an average of 10 growth points. Power Users grew an average of 13 growth points!

 - Reading: 21,964
 - Math: 26,850
- 59 districts analyzed in 22 states



Power Users Defined

- 15 or more hours in instruction
- 10 or more units completed
- 75% average unit score or higher
