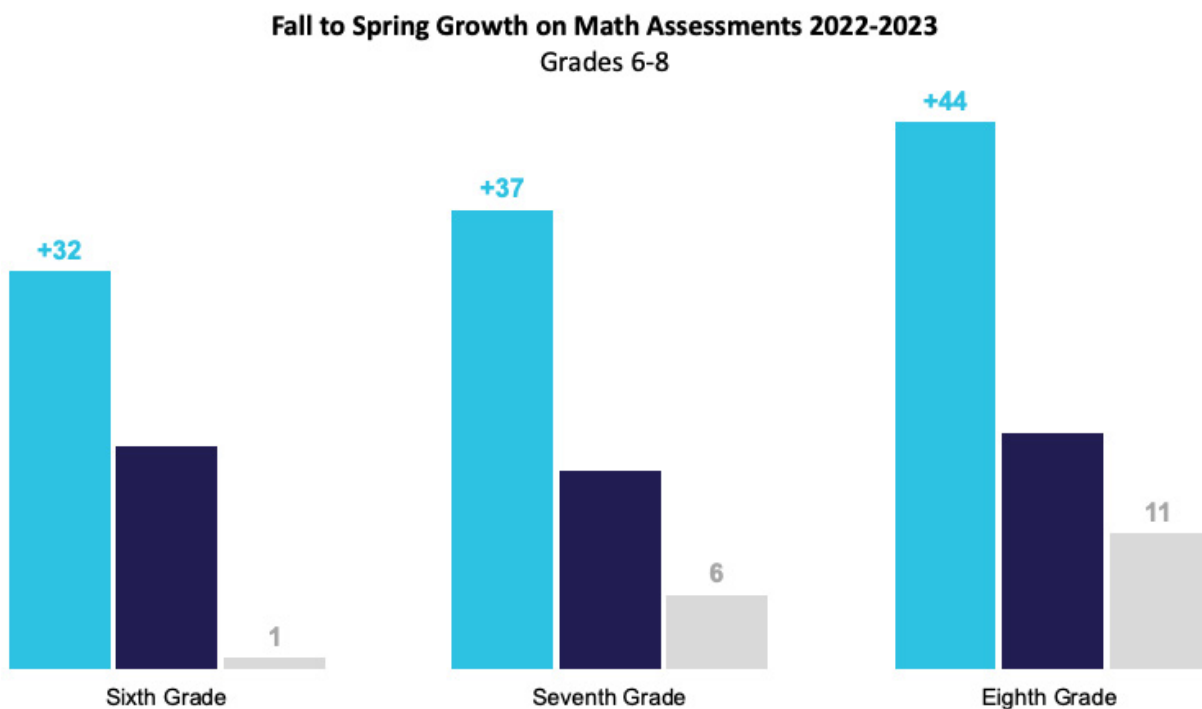


The Impact of Classworks in Middle Grades Math

Introduction

At the end of the 2022-2023 school year, an analysis was conducted to measure the growth impact from the fall to the spring Classworks Mathematics Universal Screener assessments. The growth is noteworthy! Students in middle grades who participated in Classworks Individualized Learning (IL) gained more growth from fall to spring, as reflected by their math Universal Screener assessment scores, than their peers who did not use the program. Students who used the program with fidelity experienced even more growth.



Middle Grades Math Growth - Fall to Spring 2022-2023

Students in middle grades (6-8) who worked on their Classworks Individualized Learning Path (ILP Users) experienced higher achievement on the Classworks Mathematics Universal Screener when compared to students in the same grades who did not participate (Non-ILP Users) during the 2022-2023 school year. [Students who participated in Classworks Individualized Learning for Mathematics with fidelity¹](#) gained an average of 38 growth points across all grades; with eighth grade students experiencing a gain of 33 points over students who didn't participate.

1. Power ILP Users are users who used Individualized Learning with fidelity, and who accomplished an average unit score of 75% or higher, completed two units or more a week over 30 weeks, and spent at least 30 minutes a week over 30 weeks on their Individualized Learning Path.
