


The Impact of Classworks in Middle Grades Reading

Introduction

At the end of the 2022-23 school year, an analysis was conducted to measure the growth impact from fall to spring on Classworks Reading Universal Screener assessments. Students in middle grades who participated in Classworks Individualized Learning (IL) gained more growth in reading than their peers who did not use the program. Students who used the program with fidelity experienced even more growth.

Middle Grades Reading Growth - Fall to Spring 2022-2023

Students in sixth through eighth grade who worked on their Classworks Individualized Learning Path experienced higher achievement on the Classworks Universal Screener when compared to students in the same grades who did not participate.

Students who participated in [Classworks Reading Individualized Learning with fidelity](#)¹ gained an average of 25 growth points across all grades; with sixth grade students experiencing a gain of 21 points over students who didn't participate.

1. Power ILP Users are users who used Individualized Learning with fidelity, and who accomplished an average unit score of 75% or higher, completed two units or more a week over 30 weeks, and spent at least 30 minutes a week over 30 weeks on their Individualized Learning Path.



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
