



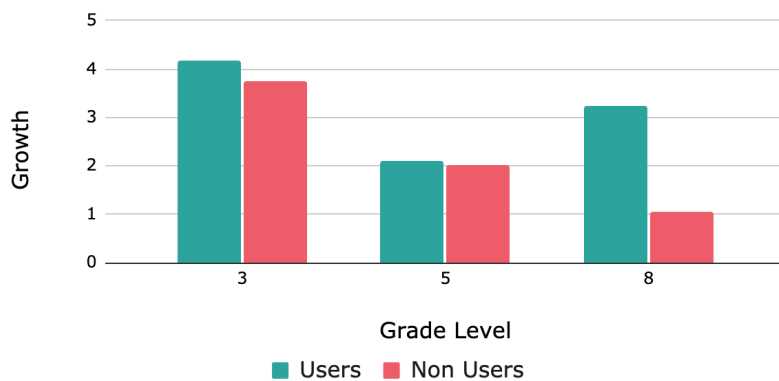

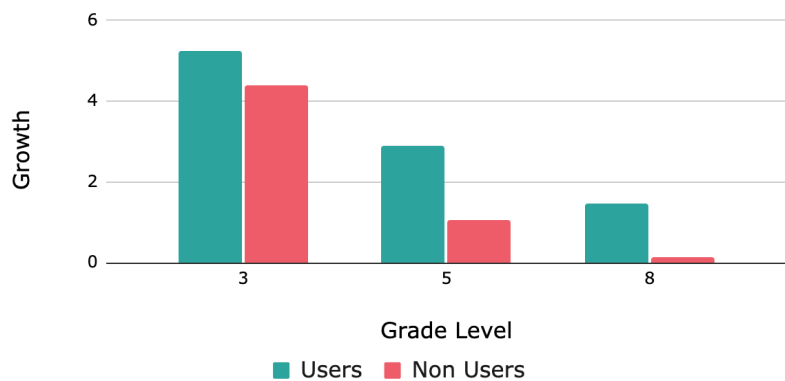

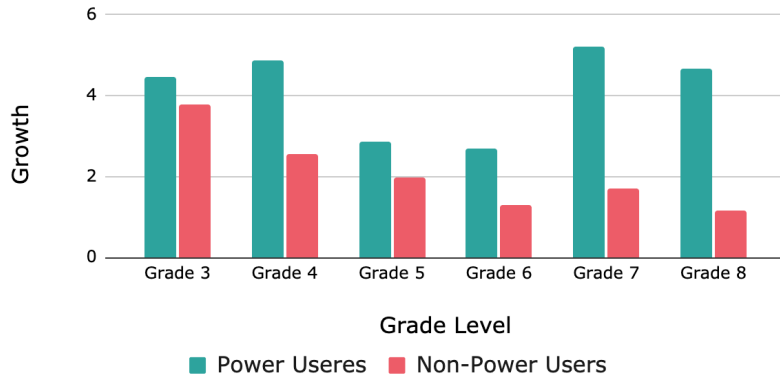
Students in key promotion grades who used Classworks experienced noticeable growth on the NWEA MAP Growth Language Arts and Math assessments when compared to students in the same grades who did not use Classworks during the same period.

Overall, students who used Classworks experienced an additional 1.70% growth in Language Arts and an additional 1.40% growth in Mathematics when compared with their peers.

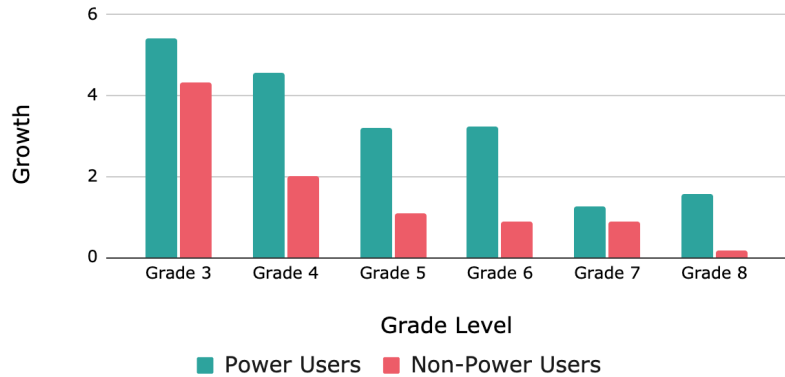

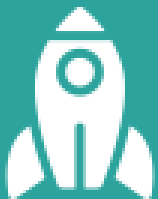

Additionally, when looking at growth from fall 2020 to spring 2021, students in grades 3-8 who followed Classworks recommended usage (power users) achieved substantially more growth when compared to students who did not in both Language Arts and Mathematics. Classworks power users achieved 2.40% more growth in Language Arts and 3.11% more growth in Mathematics compared to their peers.
